RULES FOR THE ELECTIVES FOR ALL YEARS

- Every student must take 18 electives to complete the program.
- At least 11 of the electives must be departmental electives.
- The MAXIMUM number of non-departmental electives is 7, of which maximum 4 can be taken from out-of-faculty departments.
- Out-of-department electives should bear credit values.
- Any electives taken (with advisor approval) over the maximum (18 electives) should be taken under NOT INCLUDED category.
- All students are responsible to fulfill these requirements and complete a total of 40 credited courses (must and elective) to graduate.
