RULES FOR THE ELECTIVES

1. Every student must take 14 electives in their second, third and fourth years to graduate.
2. At most SIX of the electives must be non-departmental electives.
3. The MAXIMUM number of non-faculty electives (outside FEAS) which are not listed in the curriculum is THREE.
4. Out-of- department electives should have credit values and should be at least on second year level.
5. If the student's advisor lets him/her take more electives than stated above, they should be taken under NOT INCLUDED category.
6. All elective courses (those for the 1 st and 2nd year students) must be taken under ELECTIVE category.
7. Students are responsible to fulfill these requirements to graduate
