**RULES FOR THE ELECTIVES IN THE THIRD AND FOURTH YEARS**

1. Every student must take **18** electives to complete the program.
2. At least **11** of the electives must be departmental electives.
3. The **MAXIMUM** non-departmental electives is 7, of which maximum 4 could be taken from non faculty departments.
4. Out-of- department electives should have credit values and should be at least on second year level.
5. If the student's advisor lets him/her take more electives than stated above, they should be taken under **NOT INCLUDED** category.
6. All elective courses (those for the 1st and 2nd year students) must be taken under **ELECTIVE** category.
7. Students are responsible to fulfill these requirements to graduate
